Alan F. McConnell, 85, of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, died Sunday, September 2, 2018 at UPMC East Monroeville. He was born November 30, 1932, in Gary, Indiana, son of the late Charles B. and Ruth (Todd) McConnell. He was a member of the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War and received a bachelor's degree in Business Administration from the University of Pittsburgh, where he was a member of the Men's Glee Club and sang with the Mendelssohn Choir of Pittsburgh. He was an Asst. Manager at Mellon Bank, then Branch Manager and Asst. Vice President with Union National Bank. Restless in retirement, Mr. McConnell, worked as a technician for Ferrellgas until age 78. His passions included classical and folk music, the Westmoreland Symphony Orchestra, the River City Brass Band, beer, football, puppies and Myrtle Beach, SC. He was of the Presbyterian faith and attended several congregations during his lifetime, including the First Presbyterian Church of Greensburg, and Fox Chapel Presbyterian Church.
