It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Ann (Khuu) Minda, age 56, who departed this life on November 1, 2024, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Ann was born on October 24, 1968, in Da-Nang, Vietnam, and experienced the heartbreaking loss of her mother, Tran Thi Ngoc Thong, just fifteen days later—a challenge that would shape her resilient spirit.

Ann is survived by her son, Eli Minda; her father, Peter Khuu; her stepmother, Yan Liang; her older brother, David Khuu; her younger sister Ashley (Khuu) Mroueh; and numerous aunts, uncles, and cousins.

At the age of 7, Ann fled her war-torn country of Vietnam with her father, older brother, and other family members, embarking on a journey that led them to a new life in the United States.

Growing up in a nurturing church environment, she blossomed into a smart, lively young woman with exceptional interpersonal skills. A proud 1987 graduate of Gateway High School, Ann

delighted in serving as the school mascot, a role that showcased her spirited nature.

Pursuing her passion for helping others, Ann completed her nursing degree at the University of Pittsburgh. She dedicated her career to mental health, serving as a psychiatric nurse at Western Psychiatric and later as a patient case manager for UPMC. Her tender heart and genuine desire to uplift those in pain made her a beloved figure among her patients and colleagues alike. Outside of her professional life, Ann volunteered with the American Red Cross, further demonstrating her commitment to serving others.

Ann enjoyed the finer things in life and embraced every moment with joy. She was known for sharing her material blessings, often giving generous gifts to warm the hearts of those around her. Family vacations at the beach were a cherished tradition for Ann, where laughter and love flourished among her relatives.

In 2018, she suffered a brain aneurysm and stroke that significantly impacted her life. For the past six years, she was lovingly cared for by her aunts and brother, as well as by the compassionate staff at several nursing facilities in Pittsburgh, who attended to her physical, mental, and emotional needs. Ann is now at peace, reunited with her beloved grandmother, and

resting in the embrace of our Lord Jesus.

Ann's vibrant spirit, kind heart, and steadfast love for her family and friends will be deeply
