Donald T. Corfield

Age 82, of Monroeville, formerly of Pittsburgh, passed away from a lengthy pulmonary condition on Tuesday, October 4, 2016. Don was born at St. John's Hospital on October 23, 1933, to the late William A. and Barbara Ellen (Wiser) Corfield. He was a graduate of Perry High School Traditional Academy in 1952, and attended Ohio Wesleyan University, majoring in piano/organ. He maintained a private piano/organ studio in Pittsburgh for 25 years and served in the transportation industry as purchasing agent for Dresser Leasing Corp. for 32 years. Don was a former member of the Mendelssohn Choir of Pittsburgh for 4 years and the Shadyside Presbyterian Church Chancel Choir for 57 years.
