Elizabeth Barbara "Lizzy" Williams, 10, of Monroeville died unexpectedly at home Monday, February 9, 2026. She was born May 30, 2015, to Jason and Kathleen Acerni Williams. She was a student at Ramsey Elementary School, a Girl Scout, and a lifelong member of the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Monroeville. Lizzy loved gummies, mac and cheese, and stuffed animals. 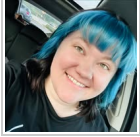
