Glenn Thomas Rosporski, of Murrysville, PA, passed away unexpectedly of natural causes on Friday, June 5, 2026, at the age of 64. Glenn is survived by his beloved wife, Maria, his children Angela (Travis), Carmen (Erin), Nina, and Mia, and his sister Amy Swank (Joe). Glenn is preceded in death by his brother Dean and sister Laurel. Glenn was the son of the late Stanley and Janice Rosporski (née Bryan). Glenn grew up in the Brookline area of Pittsburgh.

For 37 years, Glenn worked as a dedicated union electrician with IBEW Local #5 and mentored many in the trade. He took great pride in the work he did for the City of Pittsburgh and was especially happy to see his nephew Daniel pursue a career as an electrician.

Glenn believed deeply in giving back to his community. He volunteered as an Assistant Scoutmaster with the Boy Scouts, where he affectionately became known as "G-Dawg" and helped to guide and mentor the scouts while also taking them on various adventures. He was also a devoted member of AA and remained committed to his sobriety while supporting others on their own journeys. Through sponsorship, service, and volunteer work at meetings, he offered hope, encouragement, and friendship to many.

A faithful and spiritual Catholic, Glenn lived his faith through action. He served

as an usher and greeter for masses and funerals at Mother of Sorrows Parish, volunteered at the VA, and generously offered rides to church for those who needed. His compassion and willingness to help others reflected the values he cherished throughout his life.

Glenn had a special love for nature and found joy in the beauty of the outdoors, especially Angel's Landing and Glacier, which were his favorite places. He had a gift for making people smile, whether through a helping hand, a goofy joke, or a new dance move. He never met a stranger, treating everyone with dignity, respect, and unwavering kindness. Glenn genuinely cared about others and had a remarkable ability to see and appreciate the unique qualities in everyone.

Above all, Glenn was a devoted husband, father, brother, in-law, uncle, mentor, and friend. Though he will be deeply missed by all, his legacy of service, love, faith and compassion will continue to live on in all who were fortunate enough to know his joyful spirit. May he rest in peace.
