Age 88, of Monroeville, on Wednesday, April 21, 2010. Bill was born and raised in Barnesboro, PA. After high school and a year working at the local newspaper, his interest in printing brought him to this area. After an apprenticeship with Westinghouse printing in Trafford, he moved to the William G. Johnson Company in Pittsburgh. In 1962, he and two partners went into business in Monroeville, known as ABC Press, Inc., where they served the community for 30 years. He later became owner and proprietor of Computer Composition Service. Bill spent over 3 years in the U.S. Navy as an aerial gunner, on carrier-based torpedo bombers. His squadron served in both the Atlantic and Pacific Theaters, flying off 5 different aircraft carriers. He was awarded the Presidential Unit Citation, and Air Medal with 4 clusters and the purple heart. He is survived by his loving wife, Helen "Honey Bee" (Amantea) and his daughter Barbara Kay, who is an attorney with the Justice Dept. in Washington D.C.
