John Robert "Buck" Buczowski

God took Bucky peacefully on May 23, 2018 after a long illness and 54 years of happiness and fulfillment. Buck's devotion to family and friends was legendary. His sense of humor, humility, charisma, and generosity of spirit made him universally loved. He was a tour de force whose absence will leave a void in so many lives. Buck was as large in kindness as he was in stature at 6'7 and 300 pounds. Buck was recognized as a unique athletic talent: he was a big man with a rare combination of speed strength, and agility. Despite no training or practice in the shot-put, he effortlessly won 2 WPIAL, 2PIAA, and 1 Big East shot-putting championships. Buck played football at Gateway High School where he made All-American and was selected to the Gateway Hall of Fame. He played defensive line for the University of Pittsburgh before being selected as a first round draft pick of the Oakland Raiders in 1986. He also played for the Phoenix Cardinals and Cleveland Browns before injuries cut short his career. Buck was inducted into the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame, Western Chapter. He is survived by his beloved son Brayden; his parents, Dianne and Robert; brother Jeff; sister Pam Kotvas and her husband Charles; goddaughter and niece Amanda; nephew Chuck; Brayden's mother, Rebecca; and Brayden's maternal grandparents, Leo Eger and Nancy Eubing.
