John Howard Snoke, age 87, of Monroeville, passed away on Sunday, June 19, 2022. Beloved husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. John Howard Snoke was born in Pittsburgh on June 27, 1934. He received a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry from Carnegie Institute in 1956. He was employed as a chemist with the DuPont Co. in Wilmington, Delaware, where he met his wife, Jean. Married in 1957, he accepted a position as an editor with Chemical Engineering News Magazine in Washington, DC. From 1960 to 1975, he worked on Wall Street in New York City as a manager in the public relations department of Allied Chemical Co. and later for an advertising firm. In 1976, he moved his family to Pittsburgh where they remained. Howard loved our Lord and served him faithfully over the years. As an active member of the Baptist church, he taught Sunday School for years. He later joined the Pitcairn Presbyterian Church where he served as a deacon and elder. He joined a group of men who visited inmates in the federal prison, was a Big Brother to a young boy, and visited a nursing home in Wilkinsburg, playing Bingo with the residents. In 2004, Howard joined with a core group of believers to start City Reformed Presbyterian Church in the university community of Pittsburgh, where he faithfully attended for the past 18 years. He was an enthusiastic supporter of his community group, always inviting everyone he talked with to be a part of the fellowship and to enjoy the opportunity to grow in the knowledge of the Lord with one another. Howard and Jean were married 65 years. He is survived by Jean, as well as his three

children: Julia Morales and her husband, Ignasius; Dr. David Snoke and his wife, Sandra; and Stephen Snoke and his wife, Miwa.
