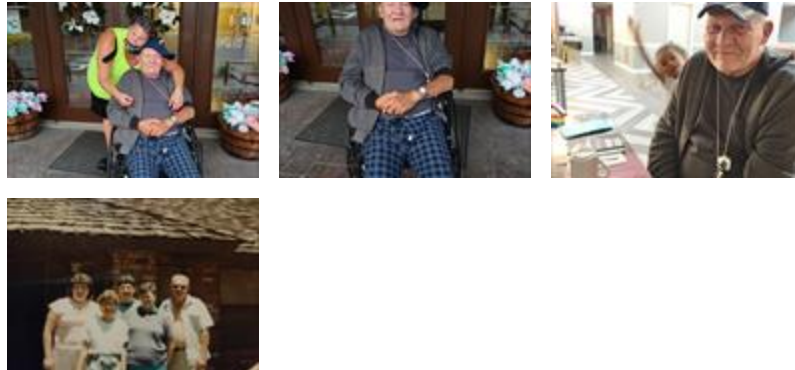

“ To my Father

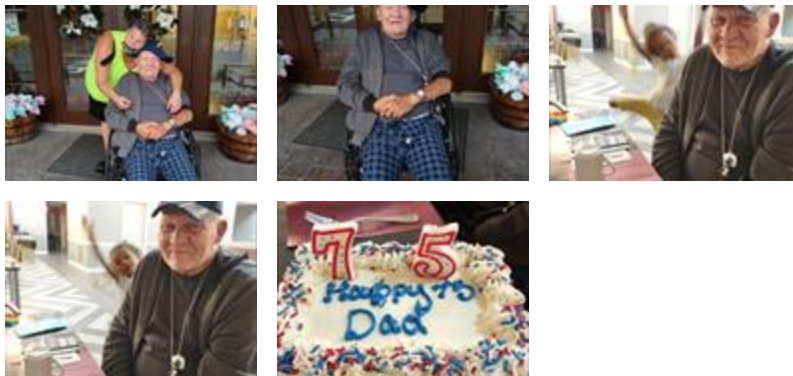
