Mary C. (Albano) Giuliana, a resident of Redstone Highlands in Murrysville, passed away peacefully with her daughters by her side, on February 2, 2021 at the age of 93. Above all, Mary enjoyed her family, especially time spent with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren and was always up for a rousing

game of Scrabble. Amazingly, at the age of 93, Mary got a smartphone for the first time, and quickly mastered texting.
