Formerly of Monroeville, died on March 16, 2016, five months before her 100th birthday. She especially loved standing in the winner's circle to get her picture taken with her sister's winning

horse! Mary's other passion was baking homemade Paska bread, pierogis and other ethnic foods for the holidays. She will be dearly missed and always remembered by her family and all that had the good fortune to meet and care for her these last years of her life.
