Nancy was born on January 22, 1931 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. She graduated from Wilksburg High School in 1949 and attended Indiana University of Pennsylvania. She married the love of her life Robert M. Holman on July 16, 1952. They moved to Monroeville in 1956 to the home where she would live for the rest of her life. Nancy was a lifelong member of the First Baptist Church of Pittsburgh. The couple welcomed their sons and instilled in them a love of family, Pittsburgh sports, and clean dishes. Her family and wide circle of friends remember her as a strong, principled and especially fun-loving woman. She was a long-time Republican Committee Woman in Monroeville. She took great pride in her work for the campaigns of Senator John Heinz, State Senator Jim McGregor, Governor Tom Ridge and many others. She worked in Human Resources for Westinghouse for 16 years. Nancy was a long time, close friend and confidant to the late Elsie Hillman. Nancy worked for Mrs. Hillman as her executive assistant for 17 years until Hillman's passing. Along with Mrs. Hillman, Nancy
