On Wednesday, December 21, 2022, Nora Yang-Ping Chang (白燕平) passed away at her home in Murrysville, PA. She was surrounded by her husband of 56 years, Shih-Chi (Matt) Chang, and her two sons, Dennis Chang of Newmarket, NH and Tom Chang of Lexington, MA. She is also survived by daughters-in-law Denise (Compel) Chang and Angela (Lih) Chang, and her four grandchildren, Emily, Rachel, Tobey, and Eli Chang. Nora was born in Nanjing, China, graduated from National Taiwan University, and immigrated to the United States in 1964 to pursue a graduate degree in sociology at the University of Pittsburgh. She married Shih-Chi in 1966 and together they raised two sons and were active members in the local Chinese community. Nora worked for the Department of Labor as a claims examiner for 26 years. During retirement, she continued to organize luncheons, weekend outings, and educational seminars for friends. An avid traveler, Nora enjoyed visiting national parks and sailing on cruise ships.
