Paul D Bullock, 96, of Monroeville, PA passed on Monday January 19, 2026 peacefully

surrounded by family at his home. Paul was born September 18, 1929 in Waterloo, NY.

He was the youngest child of the late Homer Bullock and Mary Rector Bullock.

Paul was a graduate of Albany State Teachers College, served in the US Army for 2

Monroeville for 28 years including some time as the Chief of the Mathematics Division.

retirement living in Penn Yan, NY where he was involved in the Yates County Historical

Society, including serving on the board of directors. Paul remained a die-hard Steeler

fan and could frequently be seen wearing his Steeler hat.
