Richard A. Linn, 91, formerly of Monroeville, PA, passed away suddenly on December 19, 2022 in Tucson, AZ. Born in McKeesport, PA on March 19, 1931, Rich's family later moved to the Lincoln Place area of Pittsburgh, PA. Rich served in the US Air Force during the Korean War serving as a RADAR operator on the transport planes. He worked for Power Piping as a pipe fitter until its closure. Richard is survived by his wife of 59 years, Marie (Koch) Linn, his children, Richard (Vicki) Linn, Jr. of Pittsburgh, PA, Raymond (Barbara) Linn of Tucson, AZ, Matthew (Ann) Linn of Lawrenceville, GA, and Sarah (Andrew) Lawrence of Shelocta, PA, ten grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren.
