Of Levelgreen, formerly of Forest Hills, went to be with her Lord and Maker on Wednesday, April 13, 2011, after a courageous battle with cancer. Sondra was born on December 23, 1934 in Philadelphia, PA, daughter of the late Louis and Helen Baker. Sondra was the devoted wife of William C. Amos and the loving mother of two sons, William Mark Amos, formerly of Export, PA. and Craig B. Amos of Oil City, PA. Sondra was a graduate of Wilkinsburg High School, but spent most of her adult life in the Borough of Forest Hills, where she was an active member of the Women's Club and was a volunteer driver for the Flivver and Meals on Wheels. Sondra was an active member of St. Stephens Episcopal Church in Wilkinsburg for many years. She was the first female Episcopal Lay Reader in the Pittsburgh Diocese, she sang in the choir and she was a key member of the Women's Guild. Sondra was preceded in death by her oldest son William Mark Amos in 2010. Sondra is survived by her loving husband William C. Amos of Levelgreen, her youngest son Craig B. Amos of Oil City and two grandchildren, Zachary R. Amos and Mitchell J. Amos, also of Oil City.
