Spencer Lee Krumenacker, Sr. went to be with the Lord on March 22, 2026. He was born August 1, 1939. He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Virginia; his sons Spencer, Jr. (Karen) of Mechanicsburg, PA and Wayne (Kelly) of Level Green, PA; his grandchildren Rachel of Chattanooga, TN; Rebekah of Orlando, FL; Wayne, Jr. and Luke of Level Green, PA; a brother James of Oceanside, CA; a sister Mary Mundok of Jonesboro, GA; and his nieces and nephews.

Spence graduated from Johnstown High School in 1958. He enlisted in the U.S. Army, where he became a paratrooper in the 101st Airborne Division.

After being discharged from the Army, Spence received training in Orthotics at the Johnstown Rehab Institute. Upon completion the course, he was hired by a firm in Pittsburgh. He continued his education in orthotics and received his diploma as a Certified Orthotist. Shortly after he began to work at the Children's Institute of Pittsburgh, where he specialized in pediatrics. He was employed by the Children's Institute for 25 years where he became renowned for work with children. The Children's Institute sold the orthotics department to Union Orthotics, where Spence finished his career until he retired at the age of 77.

Spence was an avid outdoorsman. He enjoyed all types of hunting. He had

beagles for rabbits and a Brittany spaniel for pheasants through the years. He was also a big fisherman. He enjoyed trout fishing with friends and family. He was great at tying flies and had a collection of hundreds for use on his favorite streams. Additionally, he enjoyed pier fishing in the ocean for mackerel and bluefish.
