- Attended Lee Grade School, and South Hills High School. He quit at 16 yrs. old and obtained his GED while in the U.S. Army.
- Veteran US Army (1957-1959) drafted.
- 1962- Robert Morris College (when it was a business school/junior college). He majored in Business Administration/Accounting.
- 1966-1972- H & R Block- started at minimum wage checking tax returns then to doing audits. Took over Downtown Pgh., and the Eastern Greater Area 16 offices, some new, some relocated. Taught income taxes in off-season.
- 1974-1987- started own business in Monroeville- the A & S Confidential Business Services- one of the few who had computerized Tax preparation software. Closed business in 1984 but kept a few accounting/tax clients throughout the years.
- Met his wife Jeanne in 1984. They married in 1992.
- 1995- Baptized as a Born-Again Christian, at the Blood Bought Church in Murrysville. Pastor Gary brought Stan to Westmoreland County Prison as a volunteer, ministering to inmates/staff in 1997. Was trained by Good News Jail and Prison Ministry and became Chaplain serving 1997-2005.
- March 2007- Received Doctorate in Biblical Theology from Grace Bible College & Seminary
- 2005-2017- Chaplain at Washington County Correctional Facility. When Good News discontinued support in the Pgh. Area, started own corporation- WCCF Ministries, Inc. with his wife Jeanne, continuing own local Ministry, until retiring at age 80, due to multiple health issues.

(MY FIRST IMPRESSION)

7/25/1995

THE MESSAGE WAS CLEAR FROM GOD.

I WAS WALKING UP CAVITT ROAD, AND THE PAIN IN MY LEGS AND BACK WAS SEVERE. I MADE IT TO THE TOP OF THE HILL WITH MUCH PAIN. I STOPPED AND TRIED TO STRETCH THE PAIN AWAY. MY LEFT LEG WAS GIVING WAY. I DID NOT HAVE THE STRENGTH TO HOLD MY WEIGHT. I WAS GOING DOWN ALL I COULD THINK WAS FIGHT, DON'T LET THIS HAPPEN. OH GOD, I AM GOING TO FALL. I SAID OUT LOUD, "OH GOD HELP ME. "

THE MAGIC WORD "GOD"! I LOOKED TO THE SKY ON THE HORIZON. SUN LIGHT WAS STREAMING DOWN, AND I HEARD A VOICE INSIDE SAY ... "FIGHT; YOU ARE NOT GOING TO FALL. GOD WILL HELP YOU. "

THE FEELING WAS INCREDIBLE; I FELT A SURGE OF STRENGTH IN MY LEFT LEG. THE PAIN WAS SUBSIDING. ALL I COULD SAY WAS THANK YOU, THANK YOU, GOD... YOU DID THIS FOR ME?? THEN THE VOICE INSIDE ME SAID, "YES, YOU ARE A CHILD OF GOD. "

I STOOD STRAIGHT UP AND TOOK A MOMENT TO DRINK IN THE SIGHT, AND THEN I PRAYED, THANK YOU, GOD, THANK YOU, GOD... I DO NOT KNOW HOW LONG I STOOD THERE, JUST BASKING IN THE FEELING. IT WAS TRULY WONDERFUL. AS I SLOWLEY WALKED BACK DOWN CAVITT TOWARD HOME, I KEPT REPEATING, "I AM GOD'S CHILD, ME, I AM GODS CHILD.

" THANK YOU, GOD. THANK YOU, GOD. I LOOKED AT THE TREES AND THE MEADOW AND THOUGHT, "GOD, YOU MUST BE EVERYWHERE. I KNOW FOR SURE THAT YOU ARE PERMANENTLY IN THIS SOUL FOREVER. PATTING MYSELF WITH THE CAIN THAT I NO LONGER NEEDED.

WHAT A FEELING; NOTHING COULD COMPARE. I KNOW OF NOTHING THAT COULD REMOTELY RELATE TO THIS FEELING OF GOOD AND WELL-BEING. ALL THE WEALTH IN THE WORLD COULD NOT BUY THIS FEELING.
