Timothy F. Cotter, age 63, passed away suddenly on Monday, March 27, 2023. Tim, aka "Buck" was born January 8, 1960, the 4th of 8 children of John "Jack" and Lois (nee Mogus) Cotter. After he graduated from Gateway Senior High School in 1978, he worked his way up to become sous chef at the Allegheny Club at Three Rivers Stadium and The Igloo Club at the Civic Arena. He then became executive chef at Pike Run Country Club in Champion, PA. After many years of working holidays, weekends, and nights, he left the kitchen to work in the natural gas industry. He spent early mornings and afternoons testing gas wells in remote areas of Central PA, a job he held at the time of his death. Tim was an avid golfer (a love of the game passed on to him by his Dad) who played golf frequently and looked forward to annual golfing vacations with his friends and family. A marriage in 1986 led to a close relationship with a stepson, Jeremy. Tim is survived by his stepson, Jeremy (Sue) Knauss and their son, Jaece, and his siblings Diane Cotter (Tim Monroe) Joyce, Paul, Michael (Donna), Ed, Karen (Christopher) Bennett and Joe (Stefany), in addition to 9 nieces and nephews, and many cousins.
